N.V. Dominio de la Vega Arte Mayor

93 points *Wine Advocate #169 (Feb 2007)* **Estimated Cost: \$50.00**



There are only 100 bottles (not cases) of the non-vintage Arte Mayor available in the USA but this sparkling wine is good enough to merit a mention. It is a blend of 60% Macabeo and 40% Chardonnay which is barrel fermented in new oak prior to the second fermentation. The nose is fragrant and super-expressive with hints of slate, mineral, clove, fresh herbs, and melon. On the palate it is mouth-filling, crisp, and intense with excellent length.

N.V. Dominio de la Vega Brut Reserva Especial

90 points *Wine Advocate #169 (Feb 2007)* **Estimated Cost: \$40.00**

The non-vintage Brut Reserva Especial is 80% Macabeo and 20% Chardonnay. Light straw-colored, it exhibits wheat thin and green apple aromas. There is a steady stream of pin-point bubbles and a subtle, elegant style with an emphasis on fruit. The finish is crisp and long.



N.V. Dominio de la Vega Brut Nature Reserva

90 points *Wine Advocate #169 (Feb 2007)* **Estimated Cost: \$40.00**



The non-vintage Brut Nature Reserva is identical to the preceding wine except that it receives no dosage. It is drier and richer on the palate and is surprisingly mouth-filling.
